# Experiences & Tours Fact Sheet



## Location

Located mid-way between Alice Springs and Uluru (Ayers Rock), Watarrka National Park covers 71,000 hectares and is home to Kings Canyon. The Resort is situated just 7km from the Canyon.

## Getting There

- Regular flights to Alice Springs or Ayers Rock Airports from most Australian capital cities.
- Just 3 hours drive from Uluru (Ayers Rock) and 4 hours from Alice Springs
- Coach companies operate regular services.



There are many touring options available in Central Australia. The following information is designed to help you take full advantage of the many experiences available to you during your visit. We strongly advise that you pre-book all touring to avoid disappointment.

### Touring Options

#### Under a Desert Moon Gourmet Experience

Imagine the romance of a table for two in a wilderness setting under a canopy of the Southern Night sky. The only light comes from the moon and the flickering glow of a campfire. The only sound is from the whispering of the breeze through the Desert Oak trees and the crackling flames. While you soak up the atmosphere, a superb six course menu is served, accompanied by some of Australia's finest wines. This is Under a Desert Moon, a private gourmet experience at Kings Canyon Resort. It is designed for intimacy and romance with no more than eight couples dining on any one night. Under a Desert Moon is a fantastic way to unwind after a day hiking through Kings Canyon and Watarrka National Park.

The experience commences 15 minutes after sunset

Duration is approximately 4 hours

Minimum 4 persons - maximum 16 persons

Under a Desert Moon is unsuitable for children under 15 years of age

Operates every night between 1st April and 31st October. Other times by direct arrangement only.

#### Kings Canyon Rim Walk - AAT Kings

Join a guided climb to the rim of Kings Canyon. Marvel at the breathtaking views of Watarrka National Park and into the canyon itself before descending into the green oasis of the 'Garden of Eden'. The walk is rocky and steep in places and is recommended for those with a good level of fitness. Alternatively, you may wish to explore the canyon floor; an easier shady walk that follows a trail between the two sheer walls of the canyon.

Departs daily between 5:00am and 8:30am depending on sunrise time and on prevailing weather conditions. Duration of tour is approximately 3.5 hours.

### Quad Adventures – Kings Creek Station

A guided tour of Kings Creek station on your own 4-wheel quad bike – an adventure you'll never forget. Journey through the rugged outback taking in spectacular scenery whilst riding through wild bush and over red sand dunes searching for wildlife. Learn a little about outback station life from the stockmen guides as you pause to view the splendour of the George Gill Range. Your adventure takes you through the cattle country where you will often see santa/shorthorn cattle and, occasionally, surprising feral camels, kangaroos and dingoes. Majestic wedge-tailed eagles are often sighted, gliding in the sky looking for prey, while below colourful parrots and other native bird life flit around in the scrub. Take the late afternoon tour and enjoy a magnificent sunset at the secluded lookout. Price includes your quad bike hire and helmet. Don't forget to bring a water bottle and your camera.
